




• WARREN PATMORE - Bashley want him

Patmore started out at Bashley in the same team as Leroy Whale. He arrived at Yeovil via spells with Cambridge United, Millwall and Northampton, plus a year when he gave up the game altogether to concentrate on golf.

Still only 25, he has been Yeovil's top scorer in his two seasons with the club, hitting 28 in 46 outings last term and 20 so far this year in 36 appearances, seven of which have been as substitute.
